

DRIVER APPLICATION & TRAINING PROCEDURE

Driver applications are accepted Weekdays, 09:00 to 16:00

Age Requirement: 25 years old is the recommended minimum age.

NOTE: Completion of the courses, and obtaining a taxi permit, does not guarantee driving privileges with Greater Edmonton Taxi Service.

Stage 1 - Documentation

The minimum following documentation, items 1, 2, 3, and 5, must be provided. Upon completing an application form, you may do the written city knowledge test. Upon passing the written city knowledge test, can then schedule a road test.

1. <u>Alberta Driver's License</u> – Class 1, 2, or 4 is required.

2. Claims Experience Letter(s) -

Personal and/or employer insurance coverage.

NOTE: If you have driven a fleet vehicle within the last five years, bus, taxi, truck, etc, a claims experience letter from your previous work place(s) is required.

- MINIMIUM of Three (3) YEARS of claims history to the present application date.
- Must show NO MORE than a 60-day lapse of coverage.
- Canadian insurance coverage is the ONLY history that will be considered.

3. Current Alberta Driver's Abstract -

- MINIMUM of Five (5) YEAR driving abstract
- NOT more than 30 days old.
- CANNOT contain any of the following violations:
 - Driving while intoxicated / impaired.
 - Driving while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
 - Driving while under suspension.
 - Careless driving, or driving without due care and attention.
 - **❖** Must *NOT* have over 5 current demerits or 4 convictions within the past 3 years.

4. Current Criminal Abstract (Security Clearance) –per Bylaw 17400

Edmonton Police Department only. This may be obtained at 14315 - 118 Ave, 780-421-2801 for hours, or at any community Police Station.

- No more than 90 days old, and no offences within the last 10 years.
- Remember to approve the vulnerable persons check.
- The security clearance is required to obtain the City of Edmonton taxi license.

J. COMPLECION OF PRIVE APPRICATION FORMS

Including minimum of two (2) work references, names and contact numbers of supervisors. An interview with a Driver Supervisor after all paperwork has been submitted.

6. Social Insurance number- REQUIRED

ONLY a government issued document with your number and your name displayed will be accepted. A hand-written note will **NOT** be accepted.

7. <u>GST number</u> - <u>REQUIRED</u> If you do not yet have a Goods and Service Tax number, an application information sheet will be provided to you. This process may take up to three (3) weeks. <u>ONLY</u> a government issued document with this number and your name displayed will be accepted. A hand-written note will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.

Stage 3 – City Knowledge Exam

- All applicants are required to complete and pass the City Knowledge Exam.
- Basic knowledge of hospitals, shopping centers, and major public places.
- The exam must be completed within 2 hours, two (2) rewrites allowed.
- Additionally, correctly answering verbal "direct route" questions.

Stage 4 – Road Test

All applicants are required to complete and pass a road test.

The applicant will be graded on following the rules of the road, ability to understand the street numbering system, and locate specific locations within the City of Edmonton.

Stage 5 – Defensive Driving Course:

- A Defensive Driving Course done at Yellow Cab will be required prior to your id being activated.
- A Defensive Driving Course done off site will not be accepted.
- A Defensive Driving Course is required a minimum of every two (2) years.
- A Defensive Driving may also be required within a month after an accident.

<u>Stage 6 – New Taxi Driver Course:</u>

- 09:00 to 17:00, lunch not provided, bring your own, north entrance, upstairs.
- Information that is covered, but not limited to is, Company policies and procedures, Computer training on the taxi tablet, and accident procedures.
- All new drivers as well as returning drivers that have be inactive for an extended length of time are required to attend.

Stage 7 – Driver ID, Final Setup

The Driver ID will be activated upon an initial payment being made towards the Driver's bond account. Documentation of SIN, GST, and completion of a Defensive Driving Course is also required before activation.

The training provided does not constitute as an offer of driving privileges. Greater Edmonton Taxi Service, and its subsidiaries, reserves the right to deny driving privileges on our fleet if any of the company criteria are not met. Greater Edmonton Taxi Service, and its subsidiaries, reserves the right to place a sub-contractor on an indefinite probationary period.
